

Exploring the Universe in El Salvador for public from 4 years old

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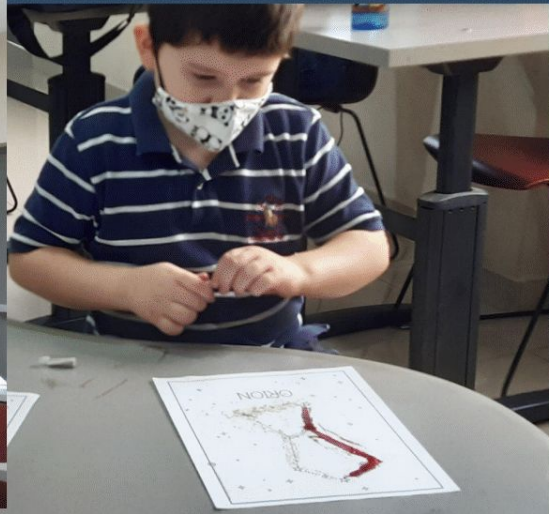

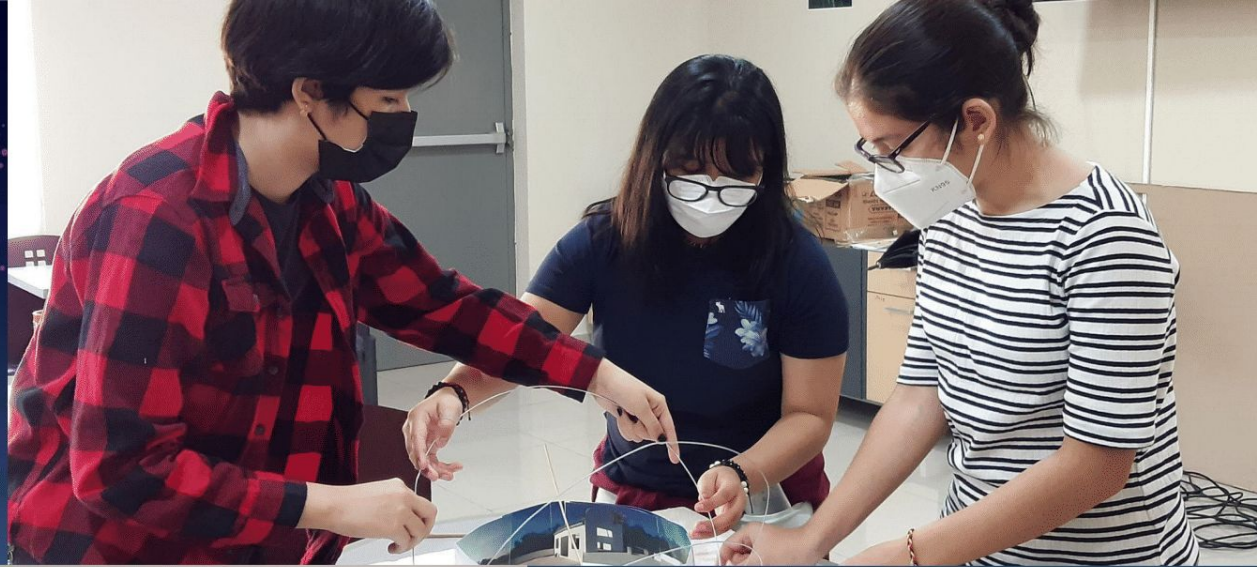


The duration of the workshop was 20 hours, distributed over a month. We used 10 hours for model construction and 10 hours of observation with telescopes and microscopes.
