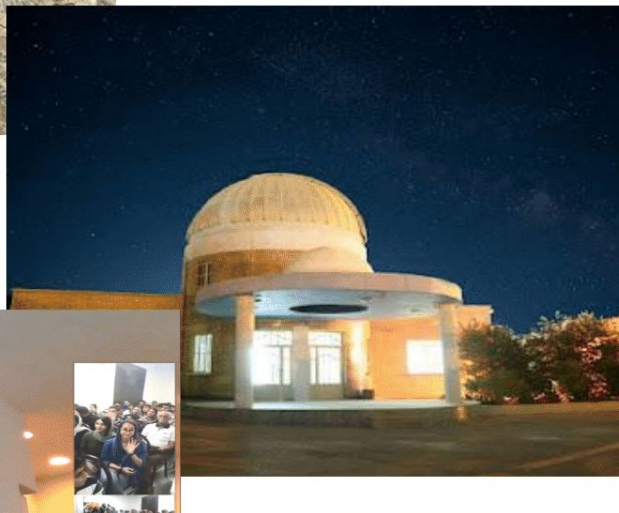

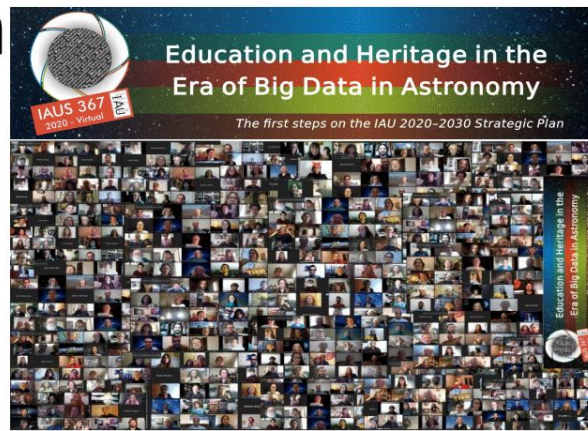

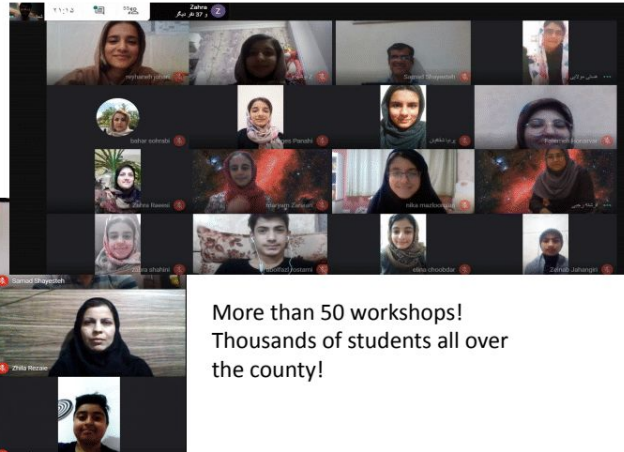
First Introduction

- Using astronomy and other activities to help them learn social skills such as team-working, event planning and management, cooperation and formal behavior

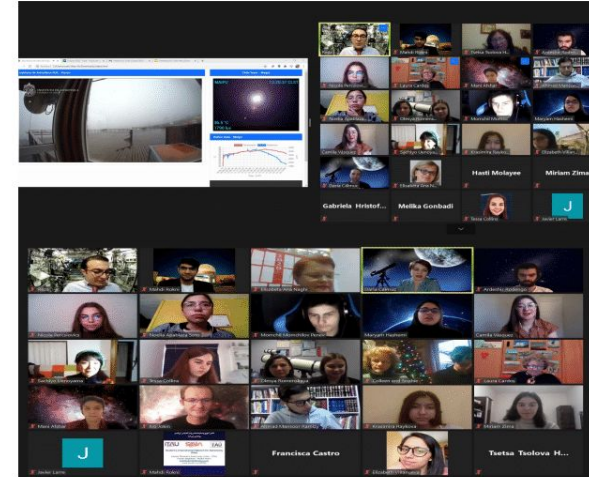

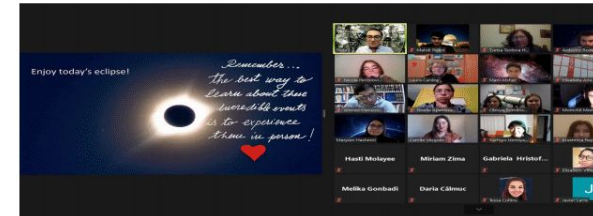

Sky Explorers festival

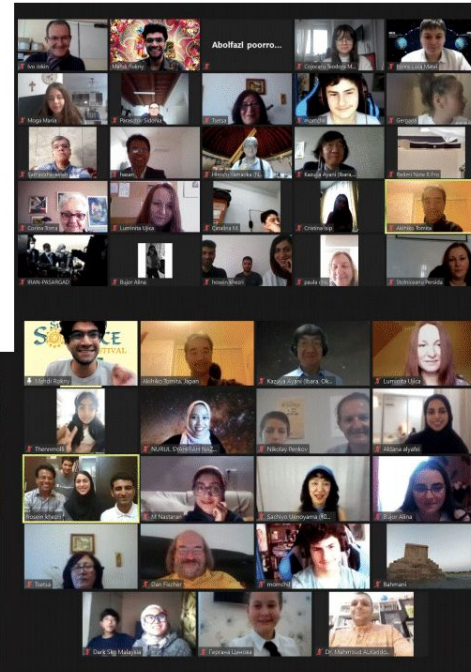


- Observing the sun with a solar telescope
